

## DATABASES

### GALE:

**Academic OneFile:** comprehensive, up-to-date database with nearly 13,000 indexed journals. Extensive coverage of the physical sciences, technology, medicine, social sciences, the arts, theology, literature and other subjects.

**General OneFile:** more than 7,000 full-text titles; more than 25 years of backfile; and five newspaper indexes. It also features more than 500 travel guides; a full collection of National Public Radio programs from 1990 to the present; links to over 5,000 video files. Full-text of the New York Times from 1985 to the present and Financial Times from 1994 to the present, updated daily.

**Military and Intelligence Database:** periodicals have been hand-selected by Gale editors to meet the content needs of libraries serving military personnel. It includes some basic reference materials that are updated annually; the Columbia Electronic Encyclopedia and The World Almanac and Book of Facts.

**Communications & Mass Media Collection:** brings together information found in more than 250 journals. Nearly 3 million articles on all aspects of the communications field.

### EBSCO:

**Communication & Mass Media Complete:** Provides the most robust, quality research solution in areas related to communication and mass media... Cover-to-cover indexing and abstracts for more than 440 journals, and selected coverage of nearly 200 more, for a combined coverage of 640 titles.

**Greenfile:** well-researched information covering all aspects of human impact to the environment. Its collection of scholarly, government and general-interest titles includes content on the environmental effects of individuals, corporations and local/national governments, and what can be done at each level to minimize these effects.

**Education Full-Text:** Full text of articles from over 350 journals as far back as 1996 and high quality indexing of nearly 750 periodicals as far back as 1983. The subject coverage is wide-ranging in scope, with substantial attention to such topics as international education, educational technology, special education, and distance learning.

**ERIC** database provides unlimited access to information from journal articles and other education-related materials. The database contains more than 1,194,000 records and links to more than 200,000 full-text documents from ERIC.

### NEWSBANK:
