



Submissions

We welcome articles and photographs concerning Air Force Reserve activities and people. Because of space constraints, articles that range from one to two typed pages, double-spaced, generally have a better chance of being published than lengthy features. However, all submissions will receive full consideration.

Because of our publication schedule (the magazine is printed every February, April, June, August, October and December), deadlines run roughly two months prior to date of publication. For instance, the deadline for receipt of all materials for the June issue is April. If you miss a deadline, all is not lost. If the story can be saved and run at a later date, we'll do it.

All articles have a much better chance of being published if they're accompanied by good photos. When it comes to photo format, we prefer color slides. If you don't shoot slides, color prints -- either 5-by-7 or 8-by-10 -- will do. Also, for those of you with the capability, we are using more and more electronic images. However, they must be high-resolution images to produce acceptable results on press. The optimum resolution is 300 pixels per inch. If you send us a low-resolution image - 72 pixels per inch, for example - we may be able to boost resolution using Adobe Photoshop software. However, the image has to be large for this method to work. Shoot for a size of at least 14 by 17 inches. If you have any questions, by all means give us a call to discuss the various options.
