Flags of Our Fathers (2006), Dreamworks Home Entertainment, 2007. Filmmaker Clint Eastwood powerfully re-creates the 1945 battle of Iwo Jima, the United States' bloodiest single engagement of World War II, offering an ironic, ultimately downbeat look at its effect on three key survivors. National Geographic - Amazing Planet (1996), Nat'l Geographic Video, 2007. (551.41 A489)

All the King's Men (2006), Sony Pictures, 2006. Remake of Robert Penn Warren's thinly-veiled portrait of Depression-era Louisiana governor Huey Long comes to the screen, this time courtesy of director and screenwriter Steven Zaillian. Willie Stark (Sean Penn) is a man of the people, and for the people; at least that's what he tells the people. (791.43 A416)

Catch a Fire (2006), Universal Studios, 2007. An apolitical South African oil-refinery worker and soccer coach is forced into terrorism as a means of fighting back against the brutality of the apartheid regime in director Phillip Noyce's dramatic look at the life of one-time political prisoner and freedom fighter Patrick Chamusso. Dog Lover's Symphony (2006), Allumination, 2006. When a troubled young man taken in by a sympathetic defense attorney befriends an abandoned dog named Toby, the effect that one simple canine has on the lives of three kindly strangers proves just how far man's best friend is willing to go to help the ones he loves. Flyboys (2006), MGM, 2007. An old-fashioned adventure yarn set during World War I, *Flyboys* calls to mind such large-scale aviation epics of Hollywood's Golden Age as *Wings*, *Hell's Angels*, and *The Dawn Patrol*. (791.43 F648)

Gridiron Gang (2006), Sony Pictures, 2007. The true story of the football team that proved sometimes second chances can make a difference comes to the screen in director Phil Joanou's tale of self-respect and social responsibility on the gridiron. *The Rock*, Sean Porter stars. (791.43 G847)
